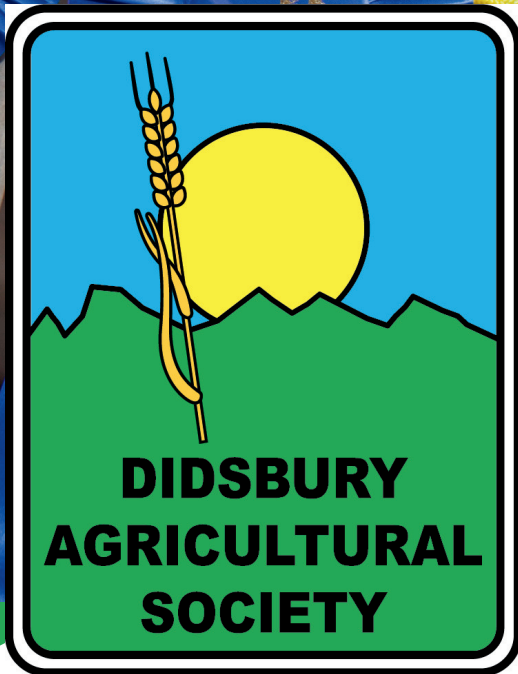

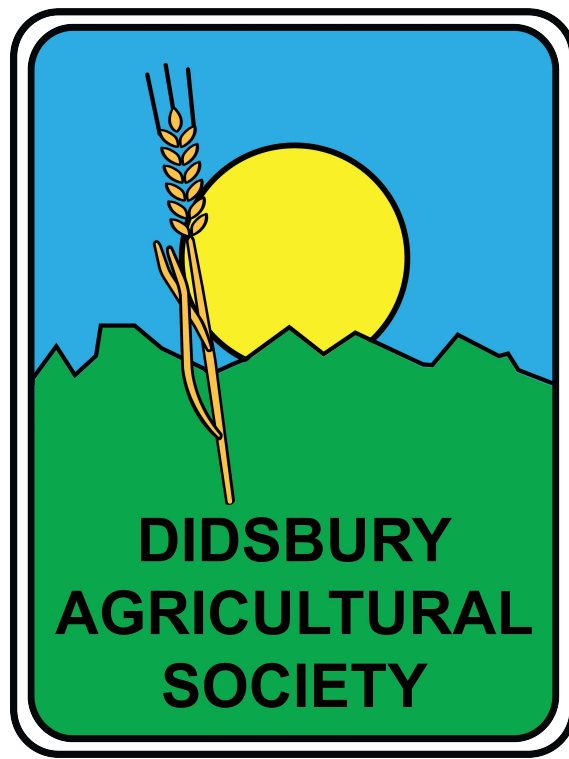

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The entire show will be run under the rules of the Didsbury Agricultural Society
2. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY.
3. All riders must be current members of the Didsbury Agricultural Society for the current year (\$10 for individuals, \$25 for a family)
4. Any protest shall be made in writing within 48hrs of the holding of the class to the Show Secretary and shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00, which sum shall be forfeited if the protest is not sustained.
5. In case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to the disqualified animal and other prizes adjusted accordingly.
6. The Show Committee shall reserve the right to combine or cancel classes if there are less than Four entries. Fees on classes cancelled will be refunded.
7. Exhibitors cancelling their entry after the official closing date shall forfeit their entry fees, except on Certificate of Disability from any certified Veterinarian or Medical Doctor prior to the start of the class.
8. The Show management and the Didsbury Agricultural Society are not responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained. Exhibitors will show their horses at their owner risk.
9. The entry numbers will be assigned to the horses, not the exhibitors. Entry numbers must be worn in a visible position before the contestant may enter the ring or be placed in a class.
10. Stallions are not to be shown by a YOUTH in any situation (Stallion handlers must be over the age of 18).
11. Manageable stallions may be shown in any division except the YOUTH Division.
12. For horse show purposes, the following definitions shall apply: YOUTH -Riders who have not passed their 18th Birthday as of January 1 of the current year SENIOR -Riders who have passed their 18th Birthday as of January 1 of the current year. JUNIOR HORSE -Is a horse which is 5 years of age and younger as of January 1 of the current year SENIOR HORSE - Is a horse which is 6 year of age and older as of January 1 of the current year.
13. NO TWO-YEAR-OLD horse/pony/draft may be shown under saddle in any performance class prior to July 1 of it's 2-year-old year.

14. The Show Committee reserves the right to split any class too large for safety.
15. There will be ribbons to 4th place in both line and performance classes, ribbons will be awarded to Champions and Reserve Champions.
16. Whips shall not be allowed in any classes except stallion line classes and driving classes
17. No person shall ride in the show or on the grounds while secured to the saddle by any means or any purpose.
18. A cheque, money order or Email Money Transfer made payable to the Didsbury Agricultural Society must accompany the entry form.
19. All Association representatives shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation and respect and no person shall direct abusive or threatening conduct toward them.
20. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL
21. ALL INHUMANE TREATMENT OF ANIMALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. Any person reported to show management as abusing a horse, anywhere on the show grounds, or causing a disturbance as to affect the conduct and safety of other horses, and/or exhibitors, and/or spectators, shall be liable for disciplinary action.
22. No smoking is permitted in the barns or arena
23. Dogs must always be on a Leash (cleanup after your dog)– No exceptions.
24. Gate Holds Gate Holds and Barn Calls are a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for the class. Gate Holds will be permitted when requested before the class previous and may be restricted to 2 minutes at the Show Committees' discretion.
25. All Junior riders must wear proper fitting, ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on the grounds.
26. Deadline for Entries is July 1<sup>st</sup>. All entries prior to the date will be entered in a draw to win their entry fees. Late entries will be accepted up until show start at an added charge of \$25 per horse.
27. Entry Fees are \$5 per class or \$50 per horse for unlimited entries
